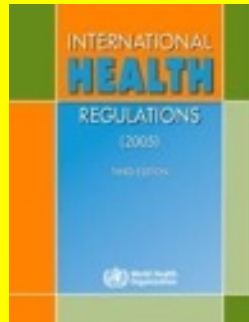

**MISSION** *To ensure a healthy, caring and sustainable ASEAN Community by promoting healthy lifestyle, responding to all hazards and emerging threats, strengthening health system and access to care, and ensuring food safety.*

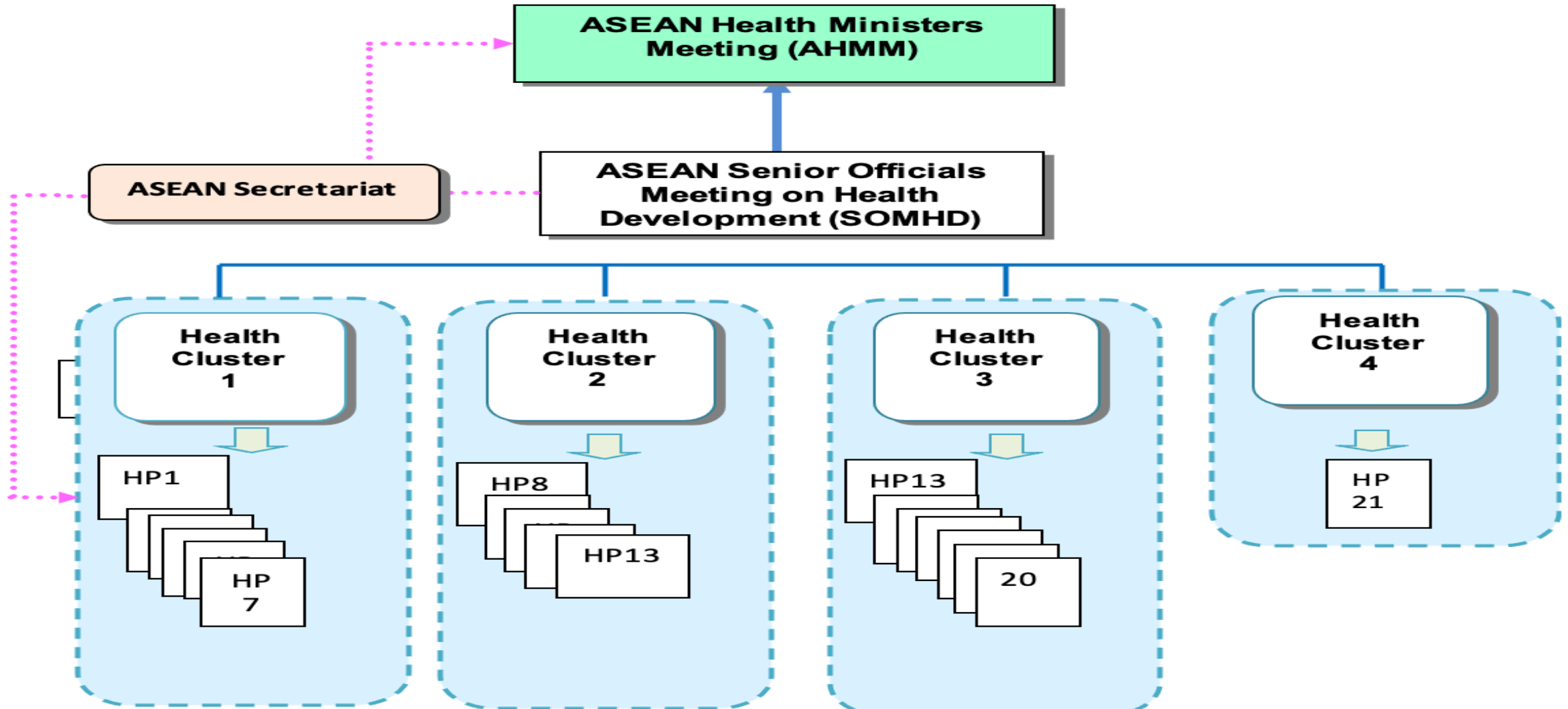

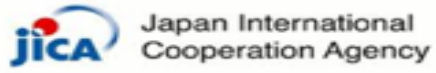
# ASEAN Post-2015 Health Development Agenda: Core Governance Structure
